Your task is to write a recount of a day you have spent at the seaside.
Firstly write notes about what you did while at the seaside (go on the beach, make sand castles, have ice creams, go for a paddle, any sea creatures you might have seen – star fish, jelly fish etc.)
Once you have made your notes then you can write your recount. Remember that a recount needs to have the following:

- A title
- Opening sentence which includes: when, who, what, where
- Time conjunctions (in the morning, after that, later, finally)
- Past tense
- First person
- Powerful verbs
- Detail to interest the reader
- Conclusion
