<u>Reading</u> Read your book every day for 20 minutes minimum. Use an iPad to check any words you don't understand. - Write down the meanings of the words so you remember	<u>Reading</u> Read your book every day for 20 minutes minimum. Sequence the story by drawing pictures or writing it out in your own words.	<u>Reading</u> Read your book every day for 20 minutes minimum. Write some questions you could answer tomorrow.	<u>Reading</u> Read your book every day for 20 minutes minimum. Answer the questions you wrote yesterday.	<u>Reading</u> Read your book every day for 20 minutes minimum. Write a book review saying what was your favourite part of your book.
<u>Writing</u> Lots of things are going on in the world at the moment! Find something positive and make bullet points about the facts.	<u>Writing</u> Use your facts from yesterday to answer - who, what, when, where and why.	<u>Writing</u> Think of a headline for the information you have researched.	<u>Writing</u> Write a newspaper report using your research and include a picture too.	<u>Writing</u> Read your newspaper report out loud as if you were presenting the news - if you like you can video this and send it to your teacher!
<u>Maths</u> Position and direction - go outside and find out where North, South, East and West are. What can you see in each direction?	<u>Maths</u> Time - Practice saying the months of the year and day of the week in order. Challenge - Can you create a calendar of the year with important dates for you on it?	<u>Maths</u> Shape - Create your name in bubble writing and count how many sides your name has in total!
