First of all, I want to stress that the following list is **not compulsory** and there is **no expectation** that they be completed. This is just a list of things that would be helpful for the children to know going in to Year 3 – having taught in Year 3 these are just off the top of my head things that I know are tricky to get their heads round sometimes. They are just some ideas if you would like anything extra to work on during school closures.

SPaG

- A **noun** is a person, place or thing.
- An **adjective** describes a noun.
- A **verb** explains the action (a doing word).
- An **adverb** describes how the verb is done.
- Capital letters are used for
 - The start of a sentence
 - Proper nouns – names of people and places
 - Days of the week and months of the year
 - The pronoun I

English

- Able to independently write a sentence with a capital letter and full stop without being reminded!
- Y1/2 spellings of HFW and able to use them in a sentence – I'll attach the list to this post.

Maths

- Number bonds to 10 (1+9, 2+8 etc)
- Times tables for 2s, 5s and 10s (you could include 3s, 5s and 8s as these are Y3 standard)
- Confident in the meaning of +, -, x, ÷ and =
- Place value of a 2-digit number – eg 45 is 4 tens and 5 ones or 40+5
- Able to tell the time to 5 minute accuracy (to 1 minute is the Year 3 standard)
