As Coningsby Authors we will:

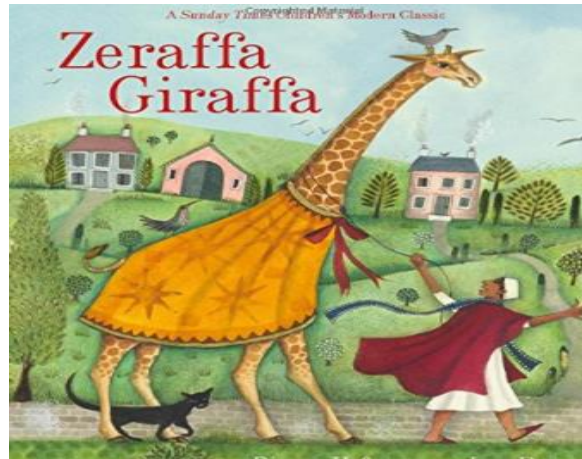
We will predict what is going to happen in a story using pictures. Use descriptive language to describe who Zeraffa is. We will also look at different types of writing such as explanation texts, dictionaries and narrative writing. We will be continuing to focus on the Year 2 high frequency words in our spellings.

As Coningsby Artists and Designers we will:

We will look at creating working cars out of shoeboxes and wooden resources. We will be using the DT equipment and learning how to do this effectively and safely.

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will:

We will start the term by looking at the properties of 3D shapes and how to sort them. We will then explore fractions by recognising, finding, naming and writing fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape and of objects. We will look at writing simple fractions and recognise the equivalent fractions. We will also look at measuring length, height and volume.



As Coningsby Historians and Geographers we will:

Be looking at our learning question: 'Planes, Trains or Automobiles?' We will look at key events of local importance and the history of transportation and examples seen at RAF Coningsby. We will be looking at where we live and what is special about it, look at how far they have travelled as well as the different ways we can travel. We will also look at designing and making a vehicle that can move.

This term our church school value is Thankfulness. In R.E we will be looking at the Christian Harvest Festival and Jewish Sukkot. We will also be studying the Dalit Madonna image from Indian culture.
