English Session 1 <u>Can I create a story map?</u> https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=aqy5ENpagts Listen to the story using the link above. On a piece of paper make a story map template with 12 squares and arrows in between to show the order of the story and draw pictures in each to show the main events. Challenge: Can you write some sentences for each picture?	English Session 2 <u>Can I capture a reader's imagination?</u> We are going to retell the story and imagine that someone had travelled from the Stone Age to the modern day – Coningsby in 2020! Put post-it notes over each part of your story map from yesterday and use these to change the story from the Stone Age to the modern day. Imagine if Om came to our school! Challenge: Can you tell a grown up about your modern day story orally?	English Session 3 <u>Can I plan my own story?</u> We are going to use our story map and work from session 2 to plan our story. Make your own story mountain to plan your story. (template below – you can print this off or make your own)	English Session 4 <u>Can I use adjectives for description?</u> Before we write our story, we are going to improve our writing by using amazing adjectives. Can you remember that adjectives are describing words? Think about Om arriving at our school and focus on the senses. Write some sentences starting... Om can see... Om can smell... Om can taste... Om can hear... Om can feel... Challenge: Can you improve one of your sentences by adding an amazing adjective?		
English Session 5 <u>Can I improve my writing?</u> Have a look through all of your work from the week and think about how we can make it better. Use a different colour pen or pencil to make some changes. Think of different sentence openers, interesting vocabulary, time conjunctions and punctuation. Challenge: Can you use any of the year 3 and 4 common exception words? (List of these also uploaded)	History <u>What changed between the Stone Age and the Iron Age?</u> Ask a grown up to help you research the changes between the Stone Age and the Iron Age. Can you make a timeline? You could even make a giant one outside!	Maths This week we are focussing on place value again.
