As Coningsby artists we will be:

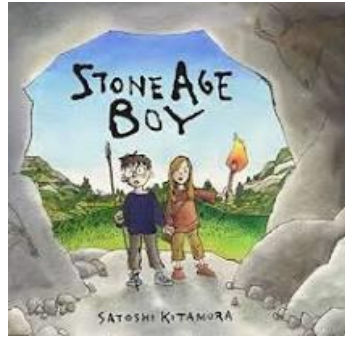
Exploring the symbols used within Stone Age art and creating cave paintings. We will also be mixing colours to make a silhouette and even make paintings and pictures using mud and water.

As Coningsby Authors we will:

Be exploring the text 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. We will be making predictions and inferences about characters' thoughts and feelings throughout the text. We will be writing diary entries, instructions and our own story, all while including new year three punctuation and language.

As Coningsby Scientists we will:

Learn about the importance of a nutritious, balanced diet and investigate how nutrients, oxygen and water are transported around the body. We will learn about the purpose of the skeleton in humans and animals and explore different types of skeletons. We will discuss healthy and unhealthy foods and also be able to say why exercise is so important.



As Coningsby believers we will:

Be learning about Hinduism and understanding their beliefs. We will explore where Hinduism was founded and what they celebrate. Our bible story of the term is about Zacchaeus and our church school value is 'friendship'.

As Coningsby Historians we will:

Be learning all about The Stone Age. We will learn to recognise key features of the past and explain what it may have been like to live during this period. We will also compare the Stone Age to modern day life.

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will:

Be learning to tell the time to five minute intervals and using this to solve word problems. We will then move onto learning about the place value of three-digit numbers.
