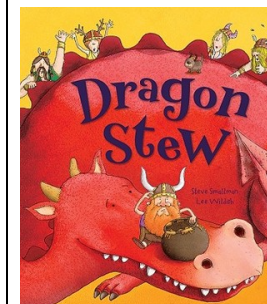

Science

Float or sink?

Collect 5 objects from around your home and write them down.

Make a prediction for each object if you think it will float or sink and write down your predictions.

Then fill a large bowl with water.

Place each object, one at a time, in the water and wait for 1 minute each to see if it floats or sinks. Write this down.

Were your predictions correct?

Why do you think some objects sank while others floated?
