Please remember this term..

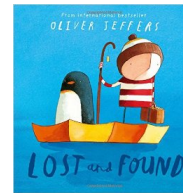
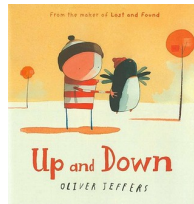
