We will be recapping and embedding previous learning such as fractions and all four operations.

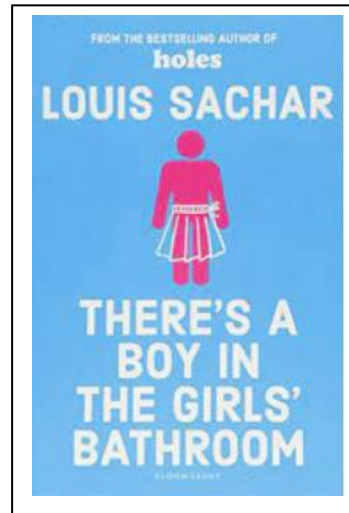
### **As Coningsby believers we will:**
