### As Coningsby Scientists we will:

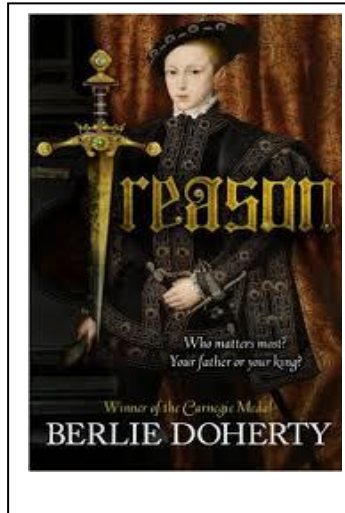
