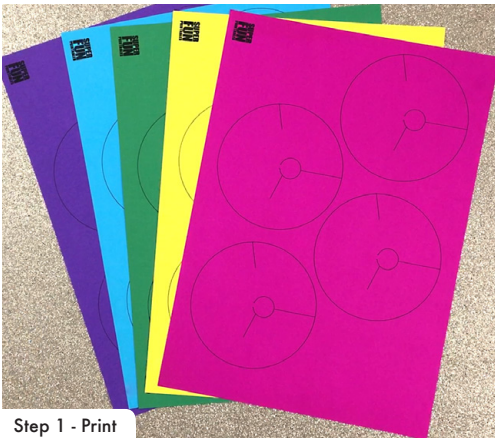


# MINI PAPER *Angels*

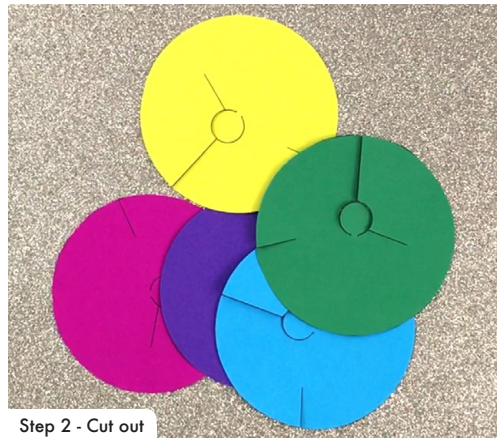
Who doesn't love angel crafts at Christmas?

These sweet paper angels have been created in the traditional style but are miniature-sized so they fit perfectly on your tree as ornaments and look great when printed on coloured paper.

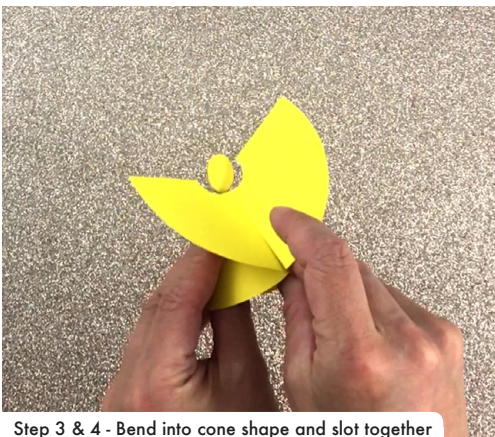
Make them your own and decorate the paper any way you choose, we've opted for plain coloured construction paper which gives a cheerful and fun look. This craft has been one of the most popular articles on my blog since the day I first shared them in Christmas 2013!



Step 1 - Print



Step 2 - Cut out



Step 3 & 4 - Bend into cone shape and slot together



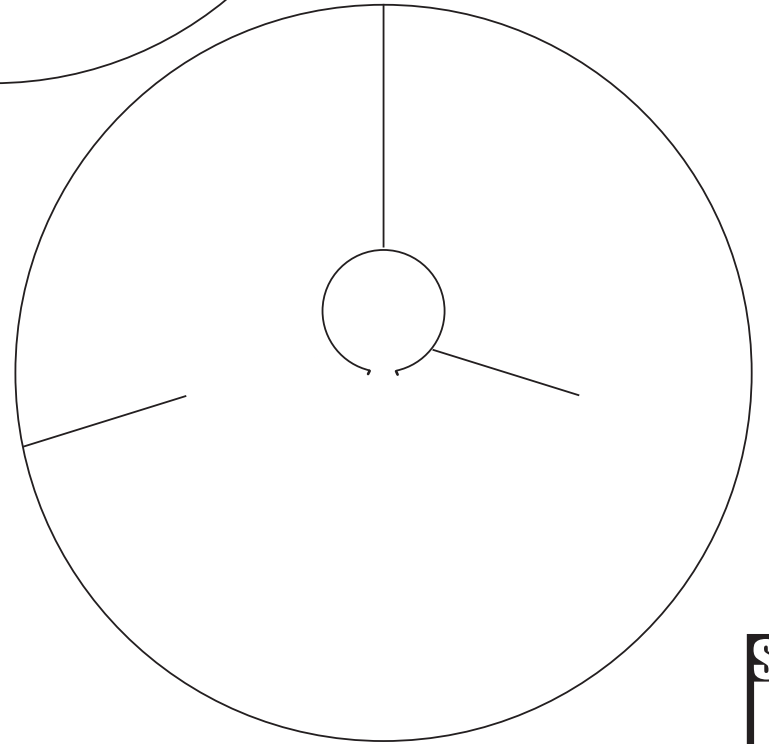
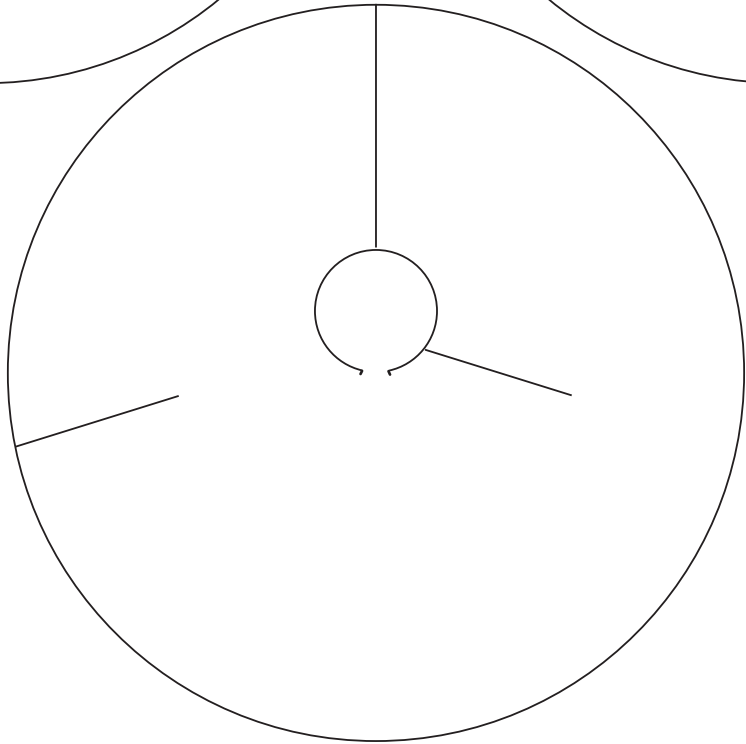
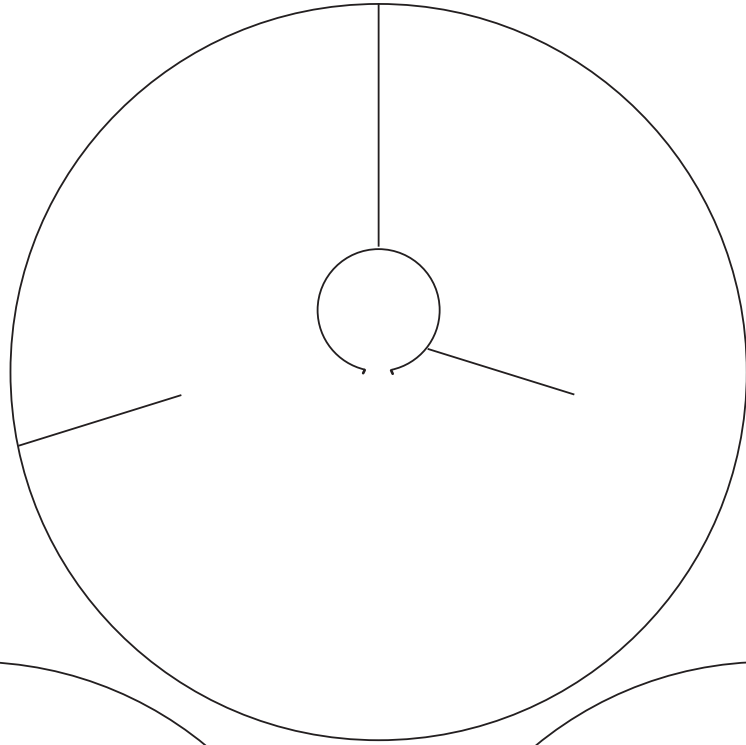
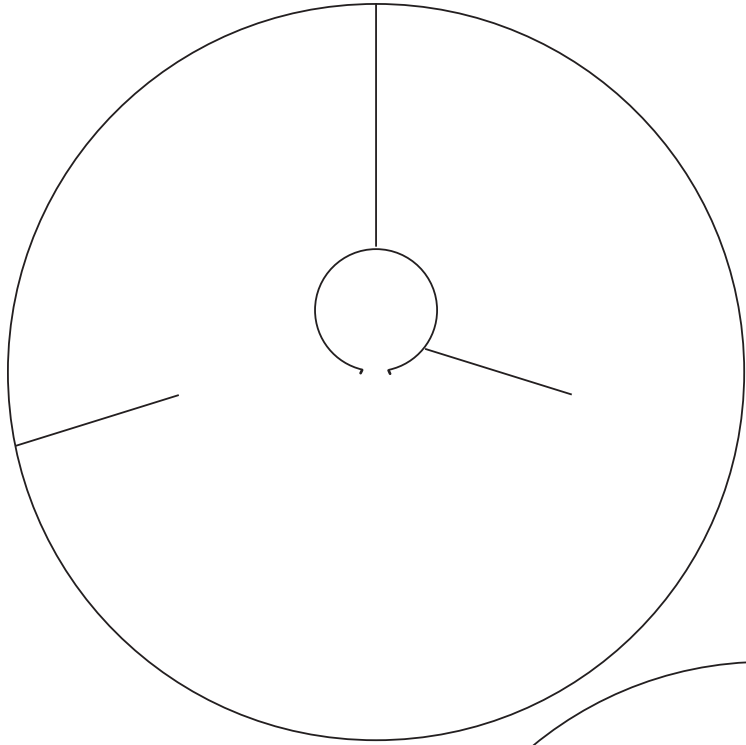
Step 6 - Add bead and string

## You will need

- Coloured construction paper
- Scissors
- String
- A small bead, the ones I've used are approx 8mm in diameter (you'll need one per angel)

## How To

- 1) Print your pattern out onto coloured paper.
- 2) Carefully cut along the black lines.
- 3) Bend the paper into a cone shape and slot the two slits which go halfway up one side together. You'll be left with an angel shape.
- 4) Thread a piece of string onto a bead and tie it into a loop for hanging.
- 5) Thread the string through the small hole left at the top of the cone behind the angel's head. The bead will keep the angel from sliding off the end of the string.
- 5) Hang them on your Christmas tree.
